

Increase max_open_files for Mysql max-connections in Ubuntu 15

Option 1) Adding this to /etc/security/limits.conf

```
mysql      soft    nofile    65535
mysql      hard    nofile    65535
```

Option 2) Modifying systemd configuration file

```
# vim /etc/systemd/system/mysql.service
```

And you will need to add following lines

```
LimitNOFILE=infinity
LimitMEMLOCK=infinity
```

For your information, you can put correct numbers instead of infinity
