

Load remote javascript code dynamically

A common approach load remote JS code is to use `<script src=..."></script>`, but sometimes you will be required to load the remote JavaScript code dynamically. Then you can simple do it by creating script element by `document.createElement('script')`

Below is an example to load JavaScript code in the header

```
function load_javascript_header(url) {  
    const script = document.createElement("script");  
    script.type = "text/javascript";  
    script.src = url;  
    script.async = true;  
    script.crossorigin = "anonymous";  
    document.head.appendChild(script);  
    eval(script);  
}
```

Below is an example to load JavaScript code in the body:

```
function load_javascript_body(url) {  
    const script = document.createElement("script");  
    script.type = "text/javascript";  
    script.src = url;  
    script.async = true;  
    script.crossorigin = "anonymous";  
    document.body.appendChild(script);  
    eval(script);  
}
```
