

# Find images in HTML with javascript

`document.getElementByName()` enables you to find objects based in tag name like `img`, `a`, ...

Below example shows how to find image objects in the HTML page:

```
const images = document.getElementsByTagName('img');

for (let i = 0; i < images.length; i++) {
    console.log(images[i].src);
}
```

If you want to filter by some criteria, you can use the `querySelectorAll()` method instead:

```
const images = document.querySelectorAll('img.my-class');

for (let i = 0; i < images.length; i++) {
    console.log(images[i].src);
}
```
