Upgrade PHP on CentOS 7/RHEL 7

I needed to upgrade PHP from version 5.6.38 to version 7.3 by the recommendation from WordPress, so tried to find the way can do that on my CentOS 7.5 server.

Below is the current version I checked on my CentOS 7.5 server:

$ php -ver

Followings are the steps I found

STEP 1.Turn on EPEL repo, enter:

 $\verb"sudo" yum -y install epel-release"$

STEP 2. Turn on Remi repo i.e.remi-php73:

sudo yum-config-manager --enable remi-php73

STEP 3. Refresh repository:

sudo yum update

STEP 4. Install php version 7.2, run:

sudo yum install php
